



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS eMM2H@JIM

APPLICATION CRITERIA

1) What is the eligible age for this application?

There are two (2) age groups :

- **Age 35 years - 49 years: and**
- **Age 50 years and above.**

2) What is the definition of add-on dependent(s)?

(i) Add-on dependents are as follows, and the pass is issued to the person who is connected to the main applicant/principle:

- **Spouse of main applicant;**
- **Children below 21 years old (biological / stepchild / legally adopted) of main applicant;**
- **Common- law wife;**
- **Disabled child regardless of age (Letter of confirmation from the medical specialist / General Practitioner).**

(ii) Social Visit Pass (Long Term) -eligible category:

- **Children 21 years old - 34 years old (biological / stepchild / legally adopted) are eligible for Social Visit Pass (Long Term) with the condition:**
 - **Single and unmarried.**
- **Parents& Parents-in-law of Principle**

Required Documents

- **Copy of passport (all pages including the cover);**
- **Copy of marriage certificate (for legal spouse) translated into English (if applicable) and attested / Certified True Copy (CTC) by the respective Embassy / High Commission / Consulate General or Consulate General in Malaysia;**
- **Copy of Birth Certificate (biological / stepchild / legally adopted) translated into English (if applicable) and attested / Certified True Copy (CTC) by the respective Embassy / High Commission/ Consulate General or Consulate General in Malaysia;**
- **Other documents specified upon request.**

NOTE:

All document must be translate in English by Institute Language and Literature. Link (<http://lamanweb.dbp.gov.my/>) or Embassy or Consulate General of Malaysia abroad link (<https://www.kln.gov.my/web/guest/malaysian-mission>).

3. Can the cancelled MM2H dependents pass holder (children holding student pass) who has completed his / her tertiary education in Malaysia, reapply as dependent, under this program?
- **Cancelled or the ex- MM2H dependent Pass holder can be considered for the reapplication of Dependents Pass, provided they are unmarried children of the principle and subject to 12 months of renewable social visit pass.**
4. Add on dependent (parents / unmarried children below the age of 21 years old) to join the MM2H program before entering Malaysia.
- **Yes, such application is allowed provided, the applicant must secure the endorsement within 6 months period upon obtaining the conditional approval.**
5. Education Background
- **This program welcomes personalities with a profound background who wish to plan their retirement in Malaysia.**
6. Minimum days in Malaysia
- **Must presence or residence in Malaysia for at least 90 days in a year or 450 days in 5 years (cumulative) must be met either ther participant or a spouse.**
 - **But no worries, we will calculate the accumulative days during the next renewal of MM2H pass.**

FINANCIAL CRITERIA

7. Applies to all categories
- **Propose to allow applicant to submit annual income with supporting documents (Rental income / Inland Revenue Statement / Share dividend / Pension / Bond Coupon etc.)**
 - **To provide the latest 3 months bank statement showing proof of liquid asset worth a minimum of RM1,500,000 and offshore income of RM40,000 per month.**
 - **Fixed deposit RM1,000,000 for main applicant and additional RM50,000 to add-on dependent(s) provided the main applicants age is between 35 to 49.**
8. Partial withdrawal from the fixed deposit allowed after one (1) year from the date of the first MM2H Social Visit Pass endorsement for the purpose?
- **Withdrawal of 50% from the fixed deposit after one (1) year is allowed for the purpose of purchase of real estate, medical and education.**
 - **Provided a letter of recommendation from the Immigration Department is obtained.**

PAYMENT

9. Payment

- **The fee to be paid to the immigration department for each social visit pass (MM2H) application:**

| No | Things | Payment Rate (RM) |

| 1 | Pass (main applicant and dependent(s)) | RM500 |
| 2 | Processing Fee (Principal) | RM5,000 for principal where RM500 must be paid when the application is submitted and non-refundable regardless to the approval of the application. |
| 3 | Processing Fee (dependent(s)) | RM2,500 for each dependent where RM500 must be paid when the application is submitted and nonrefundable regardless to the approval of the application. |
| 4 | Visa | Based on existing payment rates by country (attachment at page 7) |
| 5 | Security bond | Based on existing payment rates by country (attachment at page 8-10) |

OTHERS

10. For non-English speaking countries, have more than 20 years of driving experience in my home country and intended to own a vehicle to enjoy the retirement life here, or send Children for education; can they convert the equivalent class of driving license without sitting a written examination in Bahasa Malaysia.

- **For those from non-English speaking countries, have more than 20 years of driving experience from their country of origin and intend to own a vehicle to enjoy the retirement here, or send Children for education; can they convert the driving license without sitting for a written examination in Bahasa Malaysia.**
- **The issuance of driving license and the written examination comes under the purview of Road Transport Department Malaysia (JPJ), Ministry of Transport Malaysia (MOT). Kindly contact them via: <https://www.jpj.gov.my/> for further clarification.**

11. If the Principle of MM2H pass holder demise, can the dependents (spouse, children, add-on dependents) continue stay in Malaysia as a retirees? Can the Pass be transferred to the spouse as a new Principle?

- **The spouse is allowed to hold the dependent pass for as long as the Principal's pass is valid. He/She must submit a new application in the event demise of the Principle according to the new conditions.**

12. Direct Applicant
 - **Immigration Malaysia encourages main applicant (Principle) to apply individually through My-MM2H online application or through licensed MM2H companies / representatives.**

13. Part time employment
 - **MM2H participant are not allowed to be employed in Malaysia. BUT they are encouraged to make investments and create employment opportunities for locals.**

14. Certificate of Good Conduct (LOGC) by Wisma Putra, Malaysia
 - **Immigration Department accept a Certificate of Good Conduct issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs Malaysia for those who stay in Malaysia for one (1) year and beyond. Kindly contact them via <https://www.kln.gov.my/> -guidelines on CGC (SKB)/Panduan)**

15. Maid for home country
 - **MM2H pass holder (Principal) is allowed to bring in a domestic helper / maid from the country of origin as an Add-on Domestic Help. Visit Pass Temporary Employment (PLKS) shall be renewable yearly subject to the Fomema Medical Examination.**

16. Discontinuation
 - **Discontinuation of pass can be done manually at the MM2H counter, for those are abroad, Principals can apply for the manual discontinuation at the nearest Malaysia Mission aboard; or**
 - **The Principal or the licensed MM2H representatives / companies can submit the application for the discontinuation of the MM2H pass.**

17. Public Healthcare / Hospital
 - **Although all MM2H holder has the medical insurance, they are eligible to use the public healthcare facilities such as COVID-19 vaccination and for emergency cases. They are subject to a foreigner rate as imposed by the Government of Malaysia.**

18. Funeral in Malaysia
 - **MM2H participants next-of-kin is free to decide on the type of funeral services. Either to cremate or bury the remains locally or send the ashes back to the country of origin.**

19. MM2H CONSULTANT / AGENCY
